



Cadetships – 3 Year Programme

TUMU offer Administration, ITM or Timbers Cadetships. These are generally entry level roles and can be for young school leavers aged 17 or 18.

Preference will be given to Cadets who have completed a Gateway course through their school with TUMU.

Training

A full training programme will be developed and implemented for each successful cadet.

This will include any external course's needed that enable the cadet to be effective in their role i.e. Forklift with OSH certificate.
